Category 1: Licensed professional engineer

Applicants in this category currently hold, or have previously held, a license as a professional engineer in a Canadian jurisdiction.



Category 2: Graduate of an accredited Canadian engineering program

Applicants in this category have completed an undergraduate (i.e. Bachelor) degree at a Canadian university (or other higher education institution) in an engineering program that has been accredited by Engineers Canada. A list of accredited programs listed by institution is available at <u>www.engineerscanada.ca</u>. (Note: Masters and PhD programs are not accredited programs even if taken at a Canadian university – only undergraduate programs may be accredited)

Category 3: Graduate of a non-accredited engineering program

Applicants in this category have received confirmation from a provincial or territorial regulator of professional engineering of having met the academic requirements for licensure as a professional engineer in a Canadian jurisdiction. Please note that it is not necessary to have actually been granted a license as a professional engineer, nor to have completed the experience requirements necessary for licensure; it is just the academic requirements that must be met.

4. DOCUMENTATION

Please ensure that you have included the following documentation with this application. Failure to include all of the required documentation will result in the rejection of your application. The documentation required depends on the category of the applicant as determined in part 3 of this application. Provide only that documentation associated with your category. Place a check mark in the box \square next to the documentation you have included with your application.
